but are not known used (except in error) prior to 1960.

(*) These five TPO's / Sorting carriages running into Scotland used an AM on the date of issue of the *Forth Road Bridge* set of stamps (4th September 1964), when these stamps were available (uniquely) in Edinburgh at midnight. Only 50 covers were processed on each of the five TPO's so these are quite rare!

Caution: AM handstamps were withdrawn in 1981. Some TPO AM cancellations are known in later years, but these are almost certainly fake.
