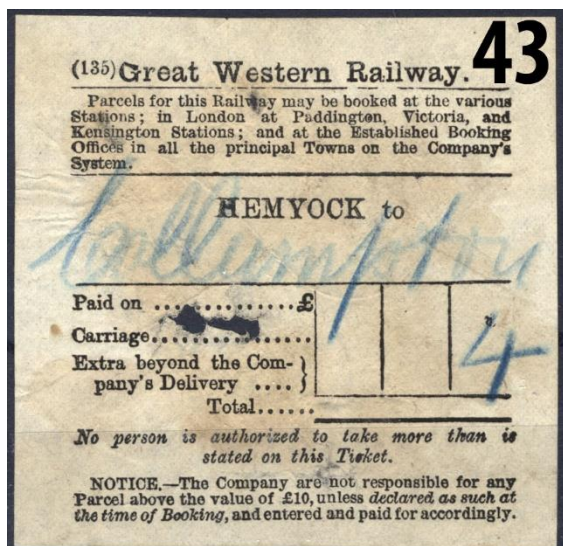

55. GREAT WESTERN RAILWAY-EDW VII 1d postal stationery envelope addressed to Felstead, Essex, cancelled by PADDINGTON machine cancel dated 18.12.1907. On the back is the GWR 2d RLS overprint on Manchester & Milford issue, tied by framed GWR cancel of PLYMOUTH STATION, dated the same day Res £45

56. LONDON, MIDLAND & SCOTTISH RAILWAY-Commercial cover addressed to Hampton, Middlesex with 5d London, Midland & Scottish parcel stamp issued & used from GLASGOW CENTRAL Station cancelled by Glasgow Central Enquiry Office cachet dated 18.6.1948 and by the London NW1 machine cancel dated the same day Res £35
57. RAILWAY AIR SERVICE FINAL FLIGHT-Cover from Preston addressed to London and sent by rail to Glasgow where it was flown down to London. The 3d LMS parcel label issued at Preston is at left and cancelled by poor date stamp for the 28<sup>th</sup> September 1934. Res £22
58. SOUTH EASTERN RAILWAY-Cover addressed to Salisbury with 1d lilac tied by London d/ring dated 28.12.1898 and with pen cross cancel. At left is the 2d RLS with similar pen cancel. Res £45
59. GREAT WESTERN & GREAT CENTRAL RAILWAYS JOINT COMMITTEE 1d prepaid parcel stamp alongside GREAT WESTERN RAILWAY 6d, both issued at HADDENHAM Station and on cover addressed to Welwyn, Herts. On the back is a double ring cancel PEMBROKE DOCK dated 2.9.1945. Cover has faults, but still very collectable Res £40
60. BRITISH RAILWAYS Paid parcel label for 1/1d tied to cover from BIRKENHEAD [WOODSIDE] Station addressed to Rhyl. Both the label & 1967 Christmas stamp are tied by RHYL machine cancel dated 5.11.1967 Res £25
61. BRITISH RAILWAYS Paid parcel label for 1/- on cover addressed to Watford with label cancelled by s/line GRAFTON & BURBAGE dated 10.9.1961. The label & stamps are also tied by London S.E.1 machine dated 11.9.1961 Res £25
62. BRITISH RAILWAYS Paid parcel label for 1/- on back of cover addressed to Watford. The label is originally from KINTBURY, but has overprinted NEWBURY and cancelled by Newbury B.R cancel dated 9.6.1961. The postage stamps on the front are tied by s/rings WATFORD/HERTS dated the following day. The instruction on the cover is "TO BE POSTED ON TPO AT BLETCHLEY" Res £25
63. BRITISH RAIL-Paid parcel label for 1/- on cover from KINTBURY [see previous item] addressed to Watford on 11.6.1961-the two different labels would make a nice page for display!! Res £25
64. BRITISH TRANSPORT COMMISSION-British Railways pair of 6d Newspaper Parcel stamps on cover addressed to London, cancelled by oval EDINBURGH WAVERLEY Station cancel dated 30.4.1961. The Scottish 3d is tied by London N.1 TV Licence slogan for the next day Res £30
65. BLUEBELL RAILWAY-10p green on white rail letter fee and the 15p overprint on the same stamp; both used [2] Res £5
66. BLUEBELL RAILWAY-Official Centenary postcard addressed to Sheffield Park station with the 10p blue label tied by oval cancel of the railway and by the Fenchurch Centenary Bluebell Railway cancel dated 7.9.1972 Res £10
67. TALYLLYN RAILWAY-Cover addressed to Chelmsford with 1/- on 11d red stamp tied by company cancel of Towyn on 7.8.1958-also posted from Towyn on same day Res £20

75. FESTINIOG RAILWAY-Pictorial card with 1d & 1/2d railway labels tied by oval FESTINIOG/T.P.O/RAILWAY CO. At right is the 5d Prince of Wales investiture tied by dated s/ring of the company on 1.7.1969 Res £6
76. TALYLLYN RAILWAY-Postcard addressed to Surrey with 25p RLS tied by RHEILFFORDD TALYLLYN dated 11.9.2009 Res £5
77. FESTINIOG RAILWAY-Postcard addressed to Sussex with 3 x 1d & a 1/- company stamps tied by oval TAN-Y-BWLCH cancels. The Welsh 5d regional is tied by d/ring PENRHYNDEUDRAETH/MERIONETH dated 23.7.1970 Res £6
78. "CALn Ry/TRANSFERRED FROM/NO [north] BRITISH/RUNNING POWER TRAIN/AT/CRIEFF JUNn" Oval cancel on piece struck in November 1936 before the opening of the Forth Bridge or when the North British Railway had running powers over the Caledonian Railway section from Stirling to Crieff Junction, which, of course, is now named GLENEAGLES STATION Res £8

79. SOUTH EASTERN/TPO-D/rings dated 2.12.1923 with index DOWN ties ½d [damaged] & 1d stamps to George King cover Res £9
80. NORWICH SORTING TENDER/DOWN-S/rings dated 19.12.1910 ties a pair of EDW VII ½d values to cover addressed to George King Res £10
81. IPSWICH SORTING CARRIAGE/NIGHT DOWN-S/ring dated 22.4.1913 ties GEO V 1d to unaddressed cover with NOT CLAIMED on the back along with West Kensington cancel dated 6 days later Res £9

99. CREWE PETERBOROUGH TPO-D/rings dated 11.5.1977 and addressed as previous lot with 11p gutter pair tied on this occasion. Taxed 41½p, the ½p, 1p and a block of four of the 10p Isle of Man postage dues are tied by same cancel on same day as previous lot Res £12
