Lots 1-84 are all UK Rwy Parcel Stamps or old / modern Rwy Letter Stamps. Lots 85-150 are wide-ranging foreign lots.

- **1. Cambrian Railway** 2d RLS on 1898 opened-out Ewen cover, remains of Llanbrynmair parcels label on back (origin) to Norwood, manuscript posting direction 'at Welshpool' . Res. £65.00
- **2.** 1909 Express legal-size Letter (4d paid) PANGBOURNE to OXFORD with manuscript rail routing, **GWR opt on Manchester & Milford** 2d RLS, some foxing on RLS perfs. M.-No/72 style red EXPRESS label, naming Oxford GWR as handover point to Royal Mail. Res. £70.00
- **3.** 1924 (23 Oct) with large 'Urgent Letter' label London S.E. (possibly Forest Hill?) to London E.C. with **Southern Railway** 4d, LS1, scarce used, especially on cover. Res. £60.00
- **4.** 1942 (11 Dec) 4(d)/3d, **Shropshire & Montgomeryshire Railway** LS1, the manuscript surcharge in deep violet-black ink. RLS on Royal Mail 2½d p.s.e, to Manchester. RLS has SHREWSBURY S&MR s/l and Royal Mail wavy line cancels. A RARE franking from a scarce railway. The RLS rate rise to 4d was on December 1st 1942. Res. £240.00
- **5.** RLS Reconstructed Pane (partial) of **Sheffield & Midland Railway Committee**. Probably the 5th issue, possibly the 6th. 10 of the 12 positions, four of the stamps with no stop after 'COMMITTEE'. (Row 4, 1&2 lacking). Scarce stamps, hard to duplicate now. Ex Stuart Phillips. Res. £85.00
- **6.** FOUR pages of reconstructed panes of **Great Eastern** Railway 2d RLS in mixed condition (and some of the mint may not have gum). Contents as follows: **Page 1 :** LS1, probably Pane A, apparently positions 1-15, 13 mint, 2 used. **Page 2 :** LS1, Pane B, 4 mint, 5 used. **Page 3 :** LS2, Pane B, 5 mint, 4 used. **Page 4 :** LS3, 7 used. (25 mint, 18 used) Ex Stuart Phillips. Res. £70.00
- **7.** THREE mint panes/12 of **L&SWR** 2d RLS: **LS18** 5 u/m & 7 m/m, once folded; **LS19** 9 u/m, 3 m/m, a surface rub in Position 3; **LS20** 9 u/m, 3 m/m. (minor toning on LS20 pane). Both LS19 and LS20 have the right-hand pane variety 'dot' to left of 'O' of 'SOUTH' in Position 12. (36) Res. £55.00
- **8.** 1907 WOOTTON BASSET to FROME **GWR** 2d RLS cover with GWR cancel. LS4, corner torn off (prior to Royal Mail FROME transit cancel). Excellent item; relatively few GWR RLS have station cancels. Res. £85.00
- **9.** 1904 (Dec 9) WILMSLOW to LANCASTER railway letter, **L&NWR** 2d, LS6, cancelled by Wilmslow oval, both stamps tied by each other's cancels. FRONT ONLY with minor staining, but very attractive. Res. £40.00
- **10.** 1903 (July 18) railway letter to Norwood via Waterloo bearing **L&SWR** 2d, handstamp 'CANCELLED' in violet and tied by Royal Mail cancellation. A very clean and fresh cover.Res. £45.00

- 11: 1898 (Dec 5) railway letter from NORTHWOOD to the Strand in London, bearing **Metropolitan Railway** 7th Issue 2d, with the usual pen cancel. Useful sender's address on back to identify the likely departure station. Central crease on cover not affecting stamps. Res. £85.00
- **12.** Very scarce usage of **Great Central & North Staffordshire Ry. Com.** 4d manuscript surcharge on 3d (LS6). The cover roughly opened but RLS is fine (some foxing) and beautifully cancelled ROSE HILL (MARPLE) G.C.& N.S. two-line obliterator, this repeated on the back (twice) along with the railway company s/l datestamp (9 Nov 1920). RARE. Res. £85.00
- **13.** Block/10 (of a pane/12) **Great Central & North Staffords Ry. Com.** 2d RLS (LS1). Just three appear to be hinged, the rest u/m, a superb multiple, ex-Wilson. (Row 1,3 and 2,3 lacking). Res. £110.00
- **14.** Full pane of 12, u/m(!), of **Cleator & Workington Junction Railway** 2d RLS (LS1). Res. £45.00
- **15.** FOUR full panes/6 of **Lancashire & Yorkshire Railway** 3d RLS (LS16), with consecutive numbers, 18511-18534 (24v, all u/m). Res. £28.00
- **16.** Four used **Great Western Railway** 2d RLS (all LS1), each with legible POSTAL cancellation, Plymouth, Taunton, Paddington & Oxford. The Paddington example plate flaw, damaged first 'N' in 'CONVEYANCE', used 1898, the others being used in 1892/93. An interesting lot Res. £15.00
- **17.** Horizontal pair of **Great Western Railway** 2d LS3 m/m, the left stamp retaining the tiny dot on the frame towards the top right corner, a feature of the second issue (LS2). A small number of the transfers appear to have included this feature. Scarce as a pair with the two types. Res. £18.00
- **18.** Horizontal pair **Great Western Railway** 2d LS6 m/m, some foxing, the left stamp with variety broken 'brickwork' under first 'E' of 'MANCHESTER' on the original M&MR stamp. Good variety to have in a pair. Res. £15.00
- **19.** One of just a handful of **ESSAY**s produced for the **Great Western Railway** overprint on the Manchester & Milford Railway stamps, (GWR) LS7. Mint without gum, rarely offered. (1) Res. £55.00
- **20. Great Western Railway** 4d used (11th Issue) with GWR Cardiff cancel, some moderate thinning at foot. This is one of the scarce examples with a manuscript (ink) control number, here 2941 in blue ink. Res. £42.00
- **21.** Used on small piece at Paddington, a **Great Western Railway** 4d (from the scarce 12th Issue) with a variety, possibly constant(?), in the form of a broken vertical bar at top right resembling an exclamation mark. Res. £22.00
- **22.** A rather tatty **North Eastern Railway** 2d, LS 121. Creases, a thin at top and foxing. Unpriced in used condition, RARE. Cancelled (on Harrogate-York line) Hammerton / xx JUL 1914 in violet, the stamp also handstamped YORK / 10.30 in black, perhaps NER handling timestamp? Res. £28.00

- **23.** A fine and fresh m/m pair of the **North London Railway** 2d, LS 4. The right-hand stamp has an eye-catching plate flaw through the first 'E' of 'FEE'. Both stamps have ink traces in the bottom cartouche, apparently kiss prints from the numbering machine. Excellent item. Res. £45.00
- **24.** Three 2d values from the **South Western & Midland / Somerset & Dorset Joint** LS 5, 9 & 10. Minor crease on LS9. two pin holes on LS10, which has a straight edge at left. A useful m/m group. Res. £18.00
- **25.** A typewriter surcharge (3d/2d) from the **South Western & Midland / Somerset & Dorset Joint LS 12.** The format varied from station to station, here applied sideways using a typewriter with a blue ribbon, reading up. The convoluted text for changing from 2d to 3d is: 'PLUS / 50 / per cent', one of those curious moments in philately. RARE. Res. £100.00
- **26.** Bottom Half of a **Cambrian Railways** sheet, LS7, 3 u/m, 3 m/m, some wrinkling to a couple of the stamps. Uncommon. Res. £28.00
- **27.** Block/4 with left and bottom margin of **Cambrian Railways** LS1, all values m/m, heavyish crease on top pair. Res. £18.00
- **28.** Block/4 with left and bottom margin of **Great Central & North Staffs,** LS8, 1 x u/m, 3 x m/m, Fresh and attractive. Res. £48.00
- **29.** Corner Block/4 with top and right margins of **Macclesfield Committee** LS3, 2 x u/m, 2 x m/m. Fine, fresh and very scarce. Res. £110.00
- **30.** Block/6 (the lower half of the sheet per Wilson's notes at foot) of **Great Central & North Staffs** LS3, 2 x u/m, 4 x m/m, extensive horizontal splitting along perfs, a fine study of accurate manuscript surcharging (ornate figure '3' on a 2d). RARE. Res. £90.00
- **31.** 1892 FRONT only of **Great Western Railway** 2d, LS1, the RLS tied by Oxford Duplex cancelling a 1d Lilac. (July 19 1892). m/s inscription 'Sent from WELLINGTON Somerset'. Res. £38.00
- **32.** 1892 envelope with **Great Western** Railway 2d, LS2, the RLS tied by two BIRMINGHAM double-ring cancels (AP 26 1901). Some foxing around the RLS, the envelope a little roughly opened at top. Res. £48.00
- **33. Cambrian Railways** 4d, LS10, top marginal, m/m with some gum loss and a small thin. Scarce stamp. Res. £22.00
- **34.** Two 4d handstamped surcharges from the **Great Central Railway**, LS18a in violet on the 2d (mint no gum) & LS 18 in bright blue on the 3d m/m, the 4d/2d from the top left corner with corner torn away (frame-line just about intact), the 4d/3d with a thinned corner. Useful stamps. Res. £16.00
- **35.** Small piece bearing **Great Central & Midland Joint Committee** 2d from the top right corner of the sheet, tied by a very clear strike reading 'MANCHESTER PARCELS DEPT ... / LONDON ROAD GREAT CENTRAL ...'. Most attractive. Res. £28.00

- **36.** N-W corner marginal of **Great Central & Midland Joint Committee** 4d, LS7, mostly still on paper, fine and fresh, good partial strike in violet of REDDISH GC & M (=Reddish North). 31 Dec cancel, year? Res. £24.00
- **37.** Battered, but scarce, mint strip/3 with heavy creases of **LBSCR** 4d/3d, LS47b, with both side margins present. Violet handstamp. Large numbers on back 6099/6103/6107. Res. £26.00
- **38.** Top left corner example on small piece of the **L&SWR** 4d/3/2d, LS51c variety. Large m/s figure '3' in violet pencil and m/s '4d' in red ink, used; appears to have FULLERTON GOODS cancel. Very fine. Res. £50.00
- **39.** Fresh N-E corner m/m **Block/4 IMPERFORATE PROOFS** of the **NORTH EASTERN RAILWAY**, the bottom left stamp with small flaw in 'POST', now partially resembling 'FOST'. A heavy crease just to the right of the two left-hand stamps. RARE. Res. £85.00
- **40.** Neat clean July 22 1905 **CALEDONIAN RAILWAY** Ewen cover bearing LS1 with variety 'dot between 'N' & 'G' of 'SINGLE'. Ewen m/s note, posted at LOCHEE WEST, a station just north of Dundee that closed in 1917; very likely to be unique. Res. £90.00
- **41.** Edward VII **GLASGOW & SOUTH WESTERN RAILWAY** cover bearing LS11, to Norwood, the RLS cancelled with the Royal Mail bars. Clean and very attractive. Res. £85.00
- **42.** Reconstructed pane/12 **GLASGOW, BARRHEAD & KILMARNOCK JOINT RLY** 2D, LS6, the first three columns a mint no gum block/9, the right-hand column a pen-cancelled strip/3. Fine and fresh. Res. £50.00
- **43.** Fine Ewen July 17 1905 **NORTH BRITISH RAILWAY** cover bearing LS7, DUNBAR to Norwood, cancelled with Royal Mail cancel London N. next morning, backstamped London S.E. two hours later! Res. £55.00
- **44.** Oct 3 1895 **WATERFORD & CENTRAL IRELAND RAILWAY** cover (m/s 'Urgent' in corner) bearing LS2, to LIVERPOOL, where back-stamped next day. RLS cancelled by DUBLIN duplex. Some foxing, a RARE example on cover from this railway. Res. £475.00
- **45.** Rather tired block/9 **CALEDONIAN RAILWAY** 2d, LS3a, sketchy gum, heavy reinforcing of perforations and staining, some pin holes and creases; very useful for plating. Res. £18.00
- **46 :** Top right corner pair of **NORTH BRITISH RAILWAY** 2d, LS9, the stamps u/m, small hinge in top margin. The right-hand stamp has a weak to completely missing outer frame-line. Fine and fresh. Res. £13.00
- **47.** 1895 S-E corner 2d of the **SLIGO, LEITRIM AND NORTHERN COUNTIES RAILWAY,** LS5, mint with patchy gum, the 'N' of 'NORTHERN' partly missing (plate flaw). Fine and fresh. Res. £24.00
- **48.** 1891 2d m/m from the **GREAT SOUTHERN AND WESTERN RAILWAY**, LS1, mint with minor adherences to gum (no thins), one short perf at right, variety minor plate flaw to 'A' of 'CONVEYANCE'. Res. £22.00

- **49.** Beautiful **BELFAST AND NORTHERN COUNTIES RAILWAY** LIMAVADY oval rly cancel on deep green 2d, the stamp also with variety 'no cross-bar to 'A' in the smaller 'RAILWAY'. Highly desirable. Res. £44.00
- **50.** TWO u/m 4d (red) **CAVAN AND LEITRIM RAILWAY** RLS, both with the bottom selvedge present. One is normal, one a variety IMPERFORATE bottom margin. Fine and very scarce. (2) Res. £48.00
- **51.** Manuscript railway cancel (signature?) on a **DONEGAL RAILWAY** 2d. plus part of two LONDON cds. Still partially on paper. Res. £18.00
- **52.** Small piece with Royal Mail 1d and **DUNDEE AND ARBROATH JOINT** 2d (red stamp, LS2) both cancelled by Norwood cds Mar 24 1908, the RLS also crayon-cancelled. Clean and attractive. Res. £22.00
- **53.** An IMPERFORATE PROOF 2d pair from the **GLASGOW**, **BARRHEAD** & **KILMARNOCK JOINT RAILWAY**, LS7, lower marginal, the margin creased, one stamp u/m, the other perhaps lightly m/m (2). Fine and rare. Res. £75.00
- **54.** A lovely used example of the **NORTH BRITISH RAILWAY** first issue, LS1, with neat, central GRANTHOUSE / N.B.RY oval cancel. The station was on the ECML, closed in 1964. Exceptional quality. Res. £22.00
- **55.** A horizontal m/m pair of the **GREAT NORTH OF SCOTLAND RLY** 4d/3D, LS14, from the N-E corner. Very fresh, very fine. Res. £16.00
- **56.** Mint, virtually no gum, **WATERFORD, LIMERICK & WESTERN RAILWAY** 2d, no stop after 'LETTERS', LS4. Fresh & scarce. Res. £38.00
- **57.** Group of SEVEN used **LBSCR** blue **PARCEL** Stamps, mixed condition as usual but overall well-above average. Brighton, Portsmouth and Willow Walk cancels seen. One each of 4d, 6d, 8d, 9d, 1/-, 1/3, 1/6 (7v) Res. £15.00
- **58.** Group of FOUR used **LBSCR Parcel** Stamps, mixed condition as usual but overall well-above average. Three are purple types pre-printed for London Bridge, 4d, 6d & 1/-; also one of the scarcer black-on-white general station types of the 1920s, a 1/- used at Mitcham. (4v) Res. £14.00
- **59.** Group of THREE **LNER & M&GNR Parcel** Stamps, mixed condition as usual but very presentable examples. Two are tall red LNER types, a 4d CANCELLED & a £5 mint no gum. The third stamp is a M&GN Joint three-farthings green parcel stamp, mint no gum. Res. £16.00
- **60.** Mint (S-E) corner block/4 **LBSCR** 2d Blue **Newspaper** Stamps (3 u/m). Pencil m/s in margin 29/9/06, the date of purchase? Fine, fresh. Res. £22.00
- **61.** Mint horiz. (S-E) corner strip/3 **LBSCR** 1d Blue **Newspaper** Stamps, one is u/m. Also dated 29/9/06 in margin. Fine and fresh. Res. £14.00

- **62.** Very early (1870s?) **LBSCR** 4d red **Prepaid Parcel** stamp, "up to 4 lbs weight, delivery within the usual boundaries". Many faults including a hole, missing corner and nibbled on two edges but a VERY RARE stamp. Serial #A9393. No cancellation. presumed used. Res. £110.00
- **63.** Three **Newspaper** stamps from the **RYMNEY RAILWAY**, 1d used black-on-yellow with top perfs trimmed off, 2d Green fine used, 3d Violet Mint No Gum (3v.) Res. £14.00
- **64.** Two pairs of **SOUTH EASTERN & CHATHAM RAILWAY** 1d **Newspaper** Stamps, one pair with small Black controls m/m and a S-E corner pair with large Red controls, mint no gum. (4v.) Res. £19.00
- **65.** *Modern RLS* : TALYLLYN RAILWAY 1/6 : Two sheets/10 u/m, #34 Plate 1C & #34a (with T.R. opt) Plate 1A (20v) Res. £16.00
- **66. TALYLLYN RAILWAY** 1/1 (1s1d) sheet/10 u/m except for one hinged stamp, Row 3,1 with broken 'y' variety. #28/29 (10v) Res. £11.00
- **67. TALYLLYN RAILWAY** 1/2 (1s2d) sheet/10 u/m, Row 3,1 with broken 'y' variety. #30/31 (10v) Res. £14.00
- **68. TALYLLYN RAILWAY** 1s1d/1s surcharge in RED sheet/10. Stamps are u/m, hinged in top margin. #26 (10v), RARE. Res. £110.00
- **69 . TALYLLYN RAILWAY** 10c (reissue in decimal curency) sheet/10 stamps u/m, Plate 1C. #43/44 (10v). Res. £11.00
- **70. TALYLLYN RAILWAY** Sir Haydn 15c sheet/10 u/m, Plate 1A. #50/51 (10v), Res. £18.00
- **71. BLUEBELL RAILWAY** Class H2 Beachy Head, #30b var. A set of SEVEN Imperforate **Progressive Proof** sheetlets/4 u/m. (28 proofs). Rare. Res. £80.00
- **72. BLUEBELL RAILWAY** SECR Centenary #36b var. Three Imperforate **Progressive Proof** sheetlets/4 u/m., one with black only, one with all colours except black, one in all colours (uncut margins) Rare. Res. £40.00
- **73. BLUEBELL RAILWAY** SECR Centenary #36 IMPERFORATE, u/m. Scarce. Res. £12.00
- **74. NENE VALLEY RAILWAY** Wansford Station Fund, TPO designs, Imperforate **Proof sheetlet/4** (uncut margins). #57-60a var. Res. £14.00
- **75. NENE VALLEY RAILWAY** Wansford Station Fund: THREE Imperforate **Proof sheetlets/4,** TPO designs, progressives, one in black only, one in all colours except black, one in issued colours but Imperf and with uncut margins. #57-60a vars. Res. £45.00
- **76. BLUEBELL RAILWAY** 'Blue Circle' issue, an IMPERFORATE **proof sheetlet/4,** #37d/38d each x 2, uncut margins. Res. £14.00

- **77. BLUEBELL RAILWAY** 'Blue Circle' issue, THREE Imperforate **Progressive Proof** sheetlets/4, one in Black only, one in all colours except Black, one in all colours Imperf (uncut margins). #37d/38d vars. Res. £48.00
- **78. BLUEBELL RAILWAY** 'Blue Circle' issue, An Imp x Perf Proof sheetlet/4, with uncut margins. #37d/38d var. The sheetlet has all three lines of horizontal perforation but is imperforate vertically. Res. £28.00
- **79. NENE VALLEY RAILWAY** #44a, Class 5MT, a printers' uncut imperforate **proof sheet** of two sheetlets/9 (arranged vertically with wide gutter between). Rare! Res. £32.00
- **80. NENE VALLEY Rly & BLUEBELL Rly <u>composite</u>** printers' imperforate **PROOF** sheet with NVR TPO sheetlet/4 #57-60a top, then gutter, then Bluebell Rly Class H #31b sheetlet/4 below. Rare! Res. £65.00
- **81. NENE VALLEY RAILWAY** printers' Perforated **proof** sheet with 2004 Santa Special NVR #56 in a sheetlet/9 with extensive printers' marginal markings. Res. £28.00
- **82. NENE VALLEY RAILWAY** TPO sheetlet/9 se-tenant vertically in a printers' **proof sheet** with Great Train Robbery sheetlet/9, Both sheets Plate 1A, imperforate and the whole with uncut margins. Rare. Res. £64.00
- **83. NENE VALLEY Rly & FFESTINIOG Rly <u>composite</u>** printers' imperforate **proof** sheetlet, the NVR sheetlet above (Steam Galas, Wartime Weekends etc. sheetlet/9 with 3x3 different values), the Ffestiniog sheetlet/9 below, comprising two views of the 1928 loco Lilla Rare! Res. £60.00
- **84. WEST HIGHLAND Rly & BLUEBELL Rly :** A composite printers' Imperforate proof sheetlet with WHR Beyer-Garratt sheetlet/9 at left and Bluebell's 'Blackmore Vale' sheetlet/9 (Plate 1A) at right (sheet bends affect its last three stamps), the two panes separated by a wide gutter, entirely imperforate. Rare! Res. £65.00
- **85. SPAIN CIVIL WAR: Montcada i Reixac** uncut sheet of 4 sheetlets with railway trucks at a factory in black & blue, u/m. These uncut sheets provide the three types. Cutting produces 3 sheetlets/4 headed 'Num' in Black, one with missing accent on the 'u'. The fourth sheetlet/4 has the 'Num' (with accent) in the 2nd colour, here blue. Uncut sheets are rare. Res. £55.00
- **86. SPAIN CIVIL WAR : Montcada i Reixac** uncut sheet of 4 sheetlets as Lot 85 above but design now 'railway tracks by junction' in black & yellow-orange, u/m. Same 4 types result, 4<sup>th</sup> 'Num' in yellow-orange. Rare. £ 60.00
- **87. USA Poster Stamps / Cinderellas,** with or without gum, 28 stamps, all with rly interest (some only in small detail). Includes scarcer. Res. £15.00
- **88.** USA Poster Stamps Hollypex: 1940 u/m set/4 single stamp sheetlets, both Perf & Imperf, small DMU in design, also 1942 Overprints on same 8 sheetlets m/m (16 sheetlets/1). Res. £18.00

- **89. USA Poster Stamps** Suburban Collectors' Club: 1935: Four imperforate sheetlets/4 in different colours (Burlington Zephyr diesel in station), mint (each sheetlet top two m/m, bottom two u/m). Very attractive. Res. £21.00
- **90.** British Columbia Private Courier: 1981/82 (Canada): Steam Loco & Horse types: Small format (perf): 1982 75c, 1\$50 (two, on dull and bright paper) and a 4\$50. Also 1981 Large format: 1oz orange, 3oz Blue; 3oz Pink, 7 vals u/m. Also, one used, small format 75c orange. (8) Res. £12.00
- **91. British Columbia Private Courier : ERRORS :** 1981/82 (Canada) : Steam Loco & Horse types : Small format : 1982 small 75c horiz. strip/3 imperf vertically; small \$4.50 a horiz Imperf pair. Also 1981 Large 1oz orange Vertical Pair imperf between pair, & 3oz Blue Imperf horiz. pair, all u/m and very scarce. (9) Res. £44.00
- **92. British Columbia Private Courier:** 1982: Steam Loco & Horse types: THREE 75c letter sheets(?), 152x189 mms, each with a small format 75c, printed in either Blue, Orange or Pink paper. Rarely seen. Res. £24.00





